



Transnationalization and transnationalism in the Christian peace movement in Western Europe (1979-1985)

My dissertation project analyses the protest in Western Europe after the NATO Double-Track Decision that was highly influenced by Christian groups as transnational actors. Therefore I am looking into processes of transnationalization within the Christian peace movement from 1979 to 1985 in the most important countries for the movement during these years, namely United Kingdom, the Netherlands and West Germany. Against the background of a genuine transnationalism by Christian theology my research concerns developments of transnational collaboration between Christian peace groups facing the nuclear threat by organizing demonstrations together, sharing ideas of peace work or by adapting new forms of protest from each other."
